



Oister Janet Lightfoot Viels was born January 7, 1959, in Lawrence County, Alabama, to the late George and Catherine Lightfoot.

With her loving husband by her side, Sister Janet Lightfoot Viers of Decatur, Alabama, departed this life on Tuesday, February 11, 2025, after a battle with breast cancer. Sister Viers last words before her transition was Calling on JESUS.

Sister Janet Lightfoot Viers graduated from Short Ridge High School in Indianapolis, Indiana, and later attended Calhoun Community College. Sister Viers worked in accounting and HR and was a health and safety technician at Wayne Farms poultry plant for 16 years. She retired in 2016.

Her Life

At age fifteen, the late Gladiolus Clay and Bishop Ernest Clay (her current Pastor and Father) accepted Sister Viers as their daughter and raised her as their own.

At fifteen, Sister Janet Lightfoot Viers started attending New Day Pentecostal Church in Indianapolis, Indiana. Sanctification and holiness were a must for Sister Viers. She committed her life to the apostle's doctrine, was baptized in Jesus' name, and received the gift of the Holy Ghost, with the evidence of speaking in tongues as the Spirit of God gave utterance.

In 1982, Sister Viers married the Love of her life, John Viers, and from their union, two children were born, Johnetta and John II. Shortly after they married, Elder Viers and Sister Viers moved to Alabama. Sister Viers's hometown was Courtland, Alabama, but the family settled in Decatur, Alabama. Sister Viers served The Living Way Apostolic Church for 40 years. She was a charter member. She served in various positions, including Sunday School Superintendent, Youth minister, teacher, secretary, and many others. Whatever she could find her hands to do, she did it well. Sister Viers served there faithfully until her death.

Because Sister Viers had a desire and a passion to help women, the Lord put it in her heart to start a non-profit organization for women. In 2009, Women Inspiring Women started its humble beginnings. Meetings were held at different restaurants or someone's home. God told Sister Viers in January 2016 that "it was time to take

WIW to the next level. "WIW needed a set place, date, and time for meetings.

Sister Viers shared her vision with her husband and pastor, and they gave their blessings. She also shared her vision with her prayer partners. At that time, they were sister Kay Davis and her daughter Johnetta Viers. She asked them to pray that God would direct her to the right place and connect her with the right ladies for the vision. God is amazing!

Sister Viers's daughter, Johnetta, had a connection with the owner of a mentoring ministry for girls ages 7-17. Through that connection with the owner and her assistant, God opened the door for WIW to hold meetings on the second Friday night.

The first meeting was held on Friday, March 11, 2016, and the rest is history! From there, WIW reached new levels of success, such as inspiring girls and women to aim high and succeed, significantly improving their quality of life. WIW developed a GED and mentoring program called Girl Talk Today for young girls.

In 2021, Sister Viers wanted to inspire more women, so she started a prayer line that has touched many lives through testimonies, the word of God, and Love. One plant, one water, but God gives the increase.

In 2017, Sister Viers wrote her first book, "Stay the Course," and that is exactly what she did through her diligent, loving, and caring spirit. She has touched so many lives. Yes, Sister Viers finished her course, and she kept the Faith.
